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MESQUITE EMPLOYEE HEALTH CENTER



WELCOME TO THE MESQUITE EMPLOYEE HEALTH CENTER.

The creation of the MEHC is the result of an innovative effort by the City of Mesquite and the Mesquite Independent School District to provide Mesquite employees with reduced-cost health care that is convenient and of the highest quality. This unique health center is housed in a modern 4400-square-foot facility and includes a family clinic with seven exam rooms, a full-fledged pharmacy, a Quest/LabCard collection site, and first-class furnishings and equipment.

CLINIC *

The MEHC clinic provides basic primary and minor emergency care with a focus on wellness and prevention. Physicals, screenings and referrals are also offered to patrons, and orders for lab work received from an outside provider can be performed at the MEHC's Quest/LabCard collection site. Please call the clinic to schedule an appointment. Children ages 2-years-old and up are welcome.

The co-pay for employee office visits is \$10. The co-pay for retiree (under age 65) office visits is \$30, and annual physicals are free. The co-pay for retiree (over age 65) office visits is \$30, and annual physicals are \$60. Insurance card and photo ID must be presented at appointment. Cash, check, Visa, MasterCard and American Express are all accepted.



PHARMACY *

The MEHC pharmacy will fill prescriptions from any doctor with no deductible requirements.** Your prescriptions may be called in, faxed or dropped off anytime. Insurance card and photo ID must be presented. The cost for generic prescriptions is \$15, formulary is \$40, and non-formulary is \$80. For a 90-day supply, co-pay triples: \$45, \$120, and \$240 (not available to retirees/dependents 65 and over). Cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, and American Express are all accepted.



* Must carry City insurance in order to participate.

** No deductible for PPO participants only. HSA participants must meet their full calendar year deductible (CYD) in order to be eligible for the pharmacy copayment amounts. The only exceptions are prescriptions on the Preventive Drug list.

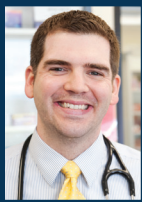
Geré Feltus, MD

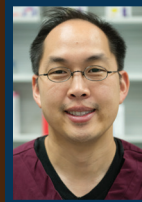
Carrie Chennault, Pharm.D.
