

Did You Know That There Is Public Transit In Mesquite?

MTED MESQUITE TRANSPORTATION FOR THE ELDERLY AND DISABLED

- MTED is operated by the City of Mesquite for residents who are seniors or disabled
- Drivers use a fleet of 11 buses to provide more than 40,000 trips each year
- Any Mesquite resident over the age of 60 is eligible for MTED service
- Any person under the age of 60 who is certified by a medical professional as having a disability is also eligible
- MTED is a demand-response, curb-to-curb, shared-ride public transportation service
- Destinations include non-emergency medical appointments, senior centers, educational facilities, and job locations
- Service is available from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday - Friday
- Customers must register with MTED in order to receive services
