

RESOLUTION NO. 51-2005

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE MESQUITE  
THOROUGHFARE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite adopted the Mesquite Thoroughfare Plan (the "Plan") with the passage of Resolution No. 36-85 on October 7, 1985; and

Whereas, since such adoption, development and other changes have occurred in the City that call for changes in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing to discuss amending the Plan on October 24, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing regarding the Plan on November 7, 2005; and


WHEREAS, at both hearings it was recommended that the Plan be amended to incorporate the extraterritorial jurisdiction, identify collector streets, realign certain streets, change local street requirements and change the classification of other streets; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed that the maximum speed limit on certain residential streets be 25 miles per hour with the passage of Ordinance No. 3770 on October 17, 2005.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Mesquite Thoroughfare Plan (the "Plan") be amended as depicted on the Proposed Thoroughfare Listing and Proposed Thoroughfare Plan Map attached hereto as Exhibit "A" to incorporate the extraterritorial jurisdiction, identify collector streets, realign certain streets, change local street requirements and change the classification of other streets.


