

Bylaws of
**KEEP MESQUITE BEAUTIFUL
STUDENT ADVISORY BOARD**

ARTICLE I - NAME

Section 1. The name of this organization shall be Keep Mesquite Beautiful Student Advisory Board (SAB).

ARTICLE II - CREATION

Section 1. The Student Advisory Board is organized to assist KMB in implementing and maintaining the Keep America Beautiful System.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE AND AIMS

Section 1. The purposes and aims of the Student Advisory Board will be charitable and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as amended. As an advisory organization to KMB the purposes and aims will be:

- A. To implement and maintain the Keep America Beautiful System to achieve sustained litter reduction.
- B. To promote interest and pride in the general improvement of the environment of Mesquite, Texas, and emphasize the benefits of a clean, healthful and beautiful area.
- C. To inspire, initiate, plan, direct and coordinate programs for litter control and prevention in cooperation with individuals, business and industry, city government, schools, and public and private organizations.
- D. To study, investigate, develop and expedite plans for improving the health, sanitation, safety and cleanliness of Mesquite. Emphasis shall be given to beautifying the streets, highways, lots, yards, business and industrial sites, parks and recreational areas, railroad rights of way and other similar places.
- E. To encourage the planting and/or preservation of trees, flowers, plants, shrubbery and other objects of natural ornamentation.
- F. To simulate interest and action toward conservation of resources through recycling.
- G. To encourage and assist in developing voluntary community improvement through enlightened leadership, thereby creating an appreciation of our city, state and country through good citizenship.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

Section 1. Membership in the Student Advisory Board shall be open to individuals in high school who support the aims and purposes of KMB.

ARTICLE V. - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. The governing body of the Student Advisory Board shall be the Board of Directors. This body shall consist of students from the five Mesquite ISD high schools selected by the KMB Executive Director.

Section 2. Directors shall serve a one year term which may be renewable for an additional three years.

Section 3. Meetings will be held on an as-needed basis. Generally, meetings will be scheduled bimonthly.

Section 4. Any member may be removed from the Board by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the entire Board. Any member may resign at any time by giving written notice to the KMB executive Director. If a director misses three (3) consecutive meetings without an excuse deemed reasonable by the KMB Executive Director, it will be considered an automatic resignation.

ARTICLE VI - EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Section 1. The Executive Director shall be the manager of the daily operations of KMB and the Student Advisory Board.

ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

Section 1. These Bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors present at any regular meeting.

ARTICLE VIII - DISSOLUTION

Section 1. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the corporation will be conveyed to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding section of any prior or future law, or to the state or local government for exclusive public purpose.
