Sealed competitive bids or proposals as set forth and required in the plans and specifications (either of which shall hereinafter be referred to as the "Bid") addressed to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas will be received at the office of Michele Brand, Manager of Purchasing and Telecommunications at the Municipal Center, 1515 N. Galloway Ave., Mesquite, Texas 75149 until **2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 14, 2010**, for the following: **Northridge Addition Sanitary Sewer Replacement, Phase 3 and 12-inch Water Main Replacement along Us 80.**

As set forth in the plans and specifications, the project is designed to include the construction of approximately 1,500 linear feet 12" SDR 26 Sanitary Sewer Pipe, 5,900 linear feet 8" SDR 26 Sanitary Sewer Pipe, 2,800 linear feet 12" C900 Class 200 (DR 14) Water Pipe, 30 manholes and 100 sewer service laterals.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 7, 2010, at the City of Mesquite Arts Center located at 1527 N. Galloway Avenue, Mesquite, Texas 75149, in the Rehearsal Hall.

Instruction to Bidders: proposal forms, plans and specifications (the "Bid Documents") may be obtained from the Engineering Division office, Municipal Center, 1515 N. Galloway, Mesquite, Texas 75149 upon a non-refundable payment of eighty dollars (\$80.00) per set.

The Bid shall be submitted on the form provided in the Bid Documents. Further information concerning the procurement may be obtained at the office of the Engineering Division – Matthew Holzapfel, PE, City Engineer, 972-216-6353 – mholzapf@cityofmesquite.com.

If bid is for \$50,000 or more, Bidder must submit, with their Bid, a Cashier's check, Certified check or a Bid Bond from an approved surety company, in the amount of five percent (5%) of their Bid as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and guarantee forms, if required, within 10 days after notice of award of contract.

The successful bidder must furnish Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the contract price, from an approved Surety company holding a permit from the State of Texas to act as surety, and acceptable according to the latest list of companies holding Certificates of Authority from the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States, or another Surety acceptable to the City.

The right is reserved by the City of Mesquite to reject any and all bids.
