1. Julie Shelton, Vice-Chairman, called the meeting to order. It was determined a quorum existed.
2. Barbara Dunn made a motion to approve the April minutes as read; Beverly Hollingsworth seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.
3. Virginia Mundt presented the Mesquite Public Library's 2018 Annual Report to the Texas State Library. She discussed expenditures, collection requirements, databases and electronic materials, and visitors, users, and checkouts.
4. Virginia Mundt distributed schedules of activities for the Main Library and the North Branch and showed a video advertising Summer Reading Club for children. Summer Reading Club for children, teens, and adults will be held in June and July. The children's club will finish with a party in August. Prizes will be given to readers of all groups.
5. Virginia Mundt discussed building traffic, items added to the library collection, and children's programs at both libraries. Book-a-Librarian and Zinio usage is increasing.

The Rodeo Parade was cancelled due to inclement weather. The Spring Book Sale was a success. Paula Sullivan, part-time Assistant Librarian, has retired. Valerie Bradley has resigned her position with the City of Mesquite and Raymond Rivas has been named Assistant City Manager, overseeing the Library Department.

The library has received a second estimate for RFID catalog installation. Virginia is exploring the possibility of renting an RFID system.

Beverly Hollingsworth has resigned from the Library Advisory Board because she is moving to Oklahoma.

6. Beverly Hollingsworth made her final motion on the Advisory Board that the meeting be adjourned; Debra Morgan seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned.
