The Texas Municipal Library Directors Association has presented the 2018 Texas Achievement in Library Excellence Award to the Mesquite Public Library System. Only 51 libraries out of 548 Texas public library systems earned the prestigious honor. This places the Mesquite Library System in the top 10 percent of all public libraries in the State of Texas. “This is the third consecutive year we have been honored with this award,” said Virginia Mundt, Director of Library Services. “I couldn’t be more proud of the team of professionals I work with and their commitment to providing outstanding programming and services.”
