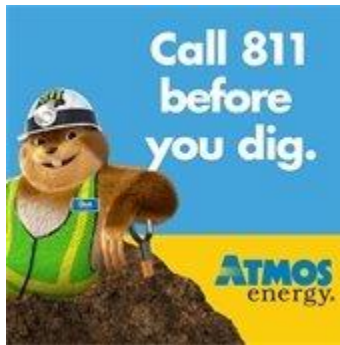
## Mesquite Arts Theatre Presents, "The Odd Couple"
