



Frequently Asked Questions

General Information

Q. When does the event start?

A. Hours are 4 p.m. – 10:30 p.m. Saturday, June 8, 2019

Q. Where is the event held?

A. Summer Sizzle takes place at Paschall Park located at 1001 New Market Road, Mesquite, TX 75149.

Q. How much does it cost to get in?

A. Entrance into the event and parking are free. There will be charges for food, drinks and some of the kids activities.

Q. What time will the fireworks begin?

A. Fireworks will begin at 10 p.m. and will last approximately 25 minutes. Please be aware that the lights in the park will turn off a few minutes before the start of the display. The fireworks display may be modified or cancelled without prior notice in the case of weather conditions.

Q. Who's playing on the Main Stage?

A. Live music is a big part of Summer Sizzle. The following bands will play on the main stage; Lara Latin, The Vinyl Stripes, and Empire 6. Performance times and band information can be found at www.cityofmequite.com/SummerSizzle

Q. What can I bring?

A. You can bring lawn chairs, blankets, strollers, picnics, coolers, sunscreen and bug spray. Remember to check the weather before you leave your house and dress accordingly.

Q. Will alcohol be sold at the event?

A. To encourage a family friendly event, no alcoholic beverages are sold.

Q. Are pets allowed?

A. Well behaved pets on a leash will be allowed inside the park.

Q. What should I leave at home?

- Please don't bring skateboards, scooters, inline skates or hover boards.
- Any form of illegal narcotics or contraband will not be allowed inside the event area.

Q. What if it rains?

A. Summer Sizzle is a rain or shine event. In the case of inclement weather, an emergency management plan will be activated. The event will be altered and parking at Travis Williams Softball Complex may not be available. In the case of inclement weather during the event, stage announcements will be made with specific instructions. Information will also be posted on the City's Facebook page.

Q. Can I leave the event and come back later?

- A. Yes, the event is free to enter, just know that if you park at Travis Williams early in the day and leave; the parking lot may be full when you come back later in the day. New Market Road will be closed to traffic at 9:30 p.m. until approximately 10:45 p.m..

Prices of Tickets/Food/Drinks

Q. What are the costs of activities?

- A. Inflatables and rides will require either an all-inclusive wristband or tickets. Wristbands are \$10 each and are good for the entire day. Tickets are \$1 each. Activities range between two to five tickets each. Ticket booths will close at 9 p.m. Activities will close at approximately 9:30 p.m. for the fireworks display.

Q. How much does the food cost?

- A. Food and beverages can be paid for with cash or credit card. Prices vary from food truck to food truck—but generally, a full meal is available for approximately \$10 per person.

Closing Times

Q. What time will the ticket booths close?

- A. Ticket booths will close at approximately 9 p.m.

Q. What time will the kid's activities close?

- A. All activities will close at approximately 9:30 p.m.

Q. What time will the concessionaires close?

- A. Concessionaires will close at the conclusion of the event, approximately 10:30 p.m.

Parking/Shuttle Buses

Q. Where can I park?

- A. Free parking is available at Travis Williams Sports Complex located at 1005 New Market Rd Space is limited and all parking is on the grass. Please note that parking at this location is weather dependent and may not be available.

Q. Are there shuttle busses?

- A. Yes, free shuttle service will be available beginning at 4 p.m. from Memorial Stadium located at: 2411 Scyene Road.
