# MESQUITE ★ VETERANS MEMORIAL

A SACRIFICE NOT FORGOTTEN



The Mesquite Veterans Memorial campaign is a community project to create public awareness and funding to build a new Veterans Memorial in Mesquite, Texas. The new memorial will be a destination to provide tribute to all military veterans and their families. The current Veterans Memorial, established in 1975, is at the flagpole in Heritage Square located in downtown Mesquite. In 2008, a group of dedicated citizens, called the Heroes of Mesquite, began an effort to build a new Veterans memorial.

On Veterans Day 2017, the City of Mesquite helped launch a new community fundraising campaign to seek public support for the design and construction of a new Mesquite Veterans Memorial. The Memorial will create a lasting memory of those men and women who served our country with honor and dignity so their sacrifice is not forgotten. In 2019, the Mesquite community will break ground on the project with plans to complete construction in 2020.



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Is this a City of Mesquite project?

No. This is a community campaign, assisted by the City of Mesquite and a citizens committee.

### Who will this memorial recognize?

The memorial will pay tribute to all military veterans and their families.

### Will individual names of veterans be placed on the memorial?

There will be opportunities for personal donations through the purchase of a brick paver or some type of permanent material to be placed at the memorial.

### When will the memorial be built?

In 2019, the Mesquite community will break ground on the project with plans to complete construction in 2020.

### Where will the memorial be located?

City Lake Park

### What is the memorial budget?

The budget will be based on the public funds donated to the project and corporate sponsorships.
