



Dallas County Health and Human Services 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Summary

March 20, 2020

- As of 10:00 am March 20, 2020, DCHHS is reporting 19 additional positive cases of 2019 novel coronavirus (COVID-19), bringing to the total case count in Dallas County to 74.
- New cases will reported as a daily aggregate, with a more detailed summary report updated Tuesdays and Fridays.
- Of the cases reported to date, clusters of transmission have been noted among attendees of recreational group gatherings and employees in office settings.
