

Description:
The number of auto thefts occur most frequently at single family residences with 175 or 37% of the YTD numbers and apartments with 141 or 29%.

Description:
58% of burglaries or breaking and entering are occurring at residential locations and 12% are occurring at rental storage facilities.

Description:
49% of reported shoplifting is happening at department stores which can be an indicator at how effective loss prevention is in the city.

Description:
49% of burglary of a motor vehicle YTD is occurring when there is an unlocked car. These numbers can be drastically improved if citizens make an effort to be more aware if they locked their car.

Selective Traffic Enforcement

These are areas that have been submitted to Police as areas of concern for speeding from residents. The Police department works with Traffic to analyze these areas and assign selective traffic enforcement to monitor these areas for a defined period of time. It helps the Police department have more success if complaints are passed along with a specific time of day the violation occurs so targeted violators are caught. These are cross streets for reference but the actual enforcement zone may be extended around the area.
