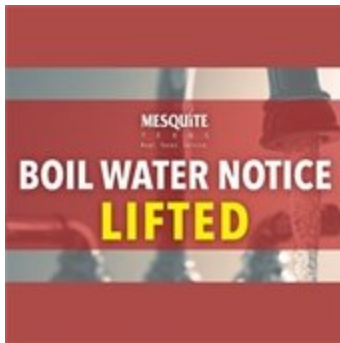

However, increased demand on the system will impact the water supply and the city is requesting all residents to take conservation measures. This was a water pressure issue, not a water quality issue. There is no need to flush lines or dispose of ice. The public is directed to call Water Utilities Dispatch at 972-216-6278 for the latest on the need for conservation or if they experience any disruption in water services to their home.
