City holds Tax Election Public Meeting on Oct. 7, 14, 26

The City will hold three public meetings about the upcoming tax election on Nov. 2. The Mesquite City Council unanimously approved the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget, which keeps the City property tax rate the same as last year. The budget adds public safety, streets and cybersecurity resources to the City's operations and maintenance of the community. State law requires that

Meter conversion project starts in October

The City of Mesquite has started a meter conversion project for all its residential and commercial water utility customers. The company Ameresco and their subcontractor Pedal Valve (PVI) were chosen to replace outdated manual meters with upgraded meters as part of an Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) project which will upgrade and modernize the City's water billing
