City Council meets on Jan. 18

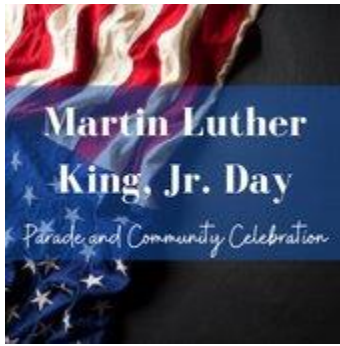

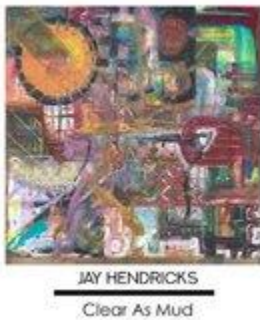
City holiday closure on Jan. 17
