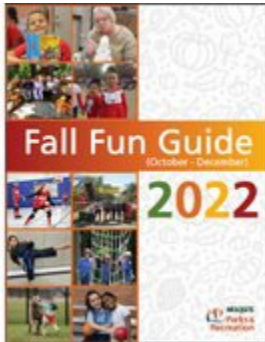
City of Mesquite water increase

The City of Mesquite implemented a 9% increase in water rates that went into effect on October 1, 2022. The rate adjustment is due to a 13% increase in the cost of water supplied by the North Texas Municipal Water District due to significant costs in the chemicals and labor needed to treat drinking water.
