## City holiday closures on Dec. 23 and Dec. 26

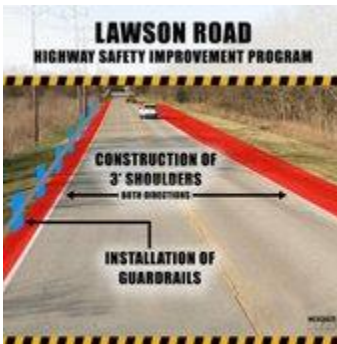
