City Council approves Downtown Façade Improvement Grant

Another Downtown Mesquite building will soon receive an update made possible by the Downtown Mesquite Façade Improvement Grant program. The property at 200 W. Davis St., owned by the Watts Family Trust, is currently occupied by the Lindstrom Law Firm. It is at the intersection of Gibson and Davis Streets. The City Council unanimously approved the application for \$2,941.62, which represents 50% of the anticipated cost of the façade improvement.
