Memorial Day Service and closures

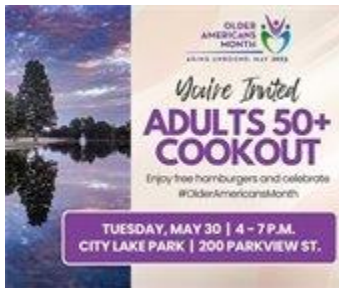
On May 29, the City of Mesquite will host a Memorial Day Service at the Mesquite Veterans Memorial, 425 S. Galloway Ave. The brief program will honor the men and women who died while serving in the United States armed forces and will begin at 2:55 p.m. to coincide with National Moment of Remembrance. Attendees are encouraged to arrive no later than 2:50 p.m. to allow time to park and enter the memorial area, and to bring folding chairs, if needed.

Also, all City offices and facilities with exception of the Mesquite Metro Airport will be closed on May 29 in recognition of Memorial Day. No trash or recycling collected.
