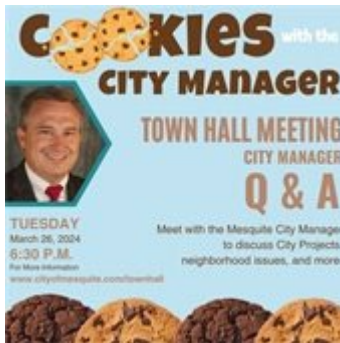
Three Mesquite women honored for shaping the community
