### Upcoming District picnics in June

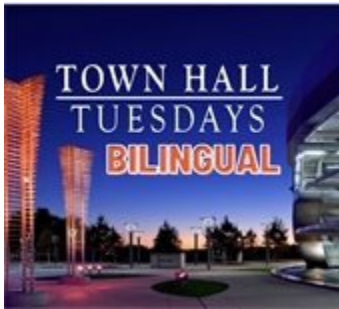
