



Swimming Pool Rules

1. Children under ten (10) years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or competent person at least sixteen (16) years of age. Children six (6) years of age and older must use gender appropriate restroom facilities.
2. Children under five (5) years of age or non-swimmers must be supervised by a responsible person who is in the water and within arms' reach of the child. Persons unable to pass a swim test must stay in water that is not over their shoulders.
3. All instructions given by the lifeguards and/or aquatics staff must be followed.
4. Admission to the pool may be denied for any of the following reasons:
 - When an individual is apparently unable to care for himself/herself.
 - Under the influence of alcohol or narcotics.
 - Evidence of contagious disease.
 - Open sores or wounds.
 - Excessively brief or revealing swim suits.
5. Candy, food or beverages are only allowed in designated areas provided for eating and drinking. No glass items, chewing gum or smoking is permitted anywhere in the facility.
6. Spitting or blowing of nose into the pool or onto deck are prohibited.
7. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated.
8. Improper public displays of affection are prohibited.
9. Walk; don't run in and around the pool facility.
10. Infants/children not toilet-trained must wear swim diapers under swimsuits. No diapers please.
11. Running, pushing or any behavior that may disturb or endanger self or others is prohibited.
12. Flotation devices, snorkels or fins will not be permitted in the pool. Life jackets may be used if they are U.S. Coast Guard approved.
13. Cut off shorts or any other makeshift swimsuits will not be permitted in the water. Tee shirts may be worn over swimwear.
14. Swimmers must stay off the lifeguard stands and not engage lifeguards in unnecessary conversation.
15. Animals are not allowed in the pool area, with the exception of guide dogs. Service animals are allowed on deck, but not in the water.
16. No forward dives, back dives, flips or spins are allowed off the side of the pool.
17. The City of Mesquite assumes no liability for the loss or theft of personal belongings. Items left in pool area at the end of the day will be placed in the pool's lost and found.
18. The pool manager or lifeguard may close any portions of/or the entire pool complex for any safety or maintenance reason.
19. All on duty aquatics staff have the authority to enforce these rules and may remove any patron who violates them. A patron will be verbally warned for the first offense and asked to leave the pool facility if a second offense occurs.
