Water meter and meter box pricing. The cost of the meters in the table above are calculated as actual City cost plus 20 percent administrative and stocking fees.

The following meter sizes are available: 5/8", 1", 1 ½" or 2" (meter sizes of 3", 4", 6" and 8" are available based on individual quotes,).

Installation of an irrigation meter on signal family homes is generally not economical for the homeowner due to capping of sewage charges and minimum monthly fees for water meters. Homeowners contemplating installation of an irrigation meter must contact the City Engineer for cost involved (engineering standards and plan requirements, inspection fees, backflow prevention, impact fees, etc..).

**The City reserves the right to determine whether a conventional meter or a radio read meter is required for each lot, structure, street or subdivision.**

### Process to obtain a Meter/Meter Box from the City of Mesquite:

- Go to 757 N. Galloway to the Water Billing Department (Office hours are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday).

- Request the meter size you need and if you also need a meter box.
- Please provide the following information:
  - the correct address where the new meter will be installed;
  - whether this is for a Commercial or Residential account; and
  - if the water meter will be a Domestic or Irrigation meter
- Pay for meter(s) and parts.
- Take receipt to the City of Mesquite Service Center located at 1101 E. Main Street. The Meter Services Office is open from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm daily and is closed for lunch from 11:00 am to 12:00 pm. Because this facility is gated, please push the button at the call box and tell the Dispatcher you are here to pick up a meter. Then drive to the center of the complex to the Field Service Building by the flagpole. Visitor parking is available across the street from the building.
- Make contact at the Dispatch window and let them know you are here to pick up a water meter from Meter Services.

### **Process to obtain a Fire Hydrant Meter from the City of Mesquite:**

Contractors are allowed to make connections to the City water system by filling out a Fire Hydrant Meter Contract and either renting a fire hydrant meter from Meter Services or using their own meter to connect to the City of Mesquite water system. The following procedures outline the rental, monthly usage, and costs:

- Go to 757 N. Galloway to the Water Billing Department (Office hours are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday).
- Fill out a Fire Hydrant Application and provide the following information:
  - Company name, contact name, billing address and phone
  - the location/site where the hydrant will be installed
- Pay deposit:
  - Hydrant Meter supplied by City: \$1,788.00
  - Meter supplied by Company/Individual: \$500.00

***Note: The deposit is 100% refundable if the contract holder meets all the requirements and returns the meter in good working condition.***

- Take receipt to the City of Mesquite Service Center located at 1101 E. Main Street. The Meter Services Office is open from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm daily and is closed for lunch from 11:00 am to 12:00 pm. Because this facility is gated, please push the button at the call box and tell the Dispatcher you are here to pick up a meter. Then drive to the center of the complex to the Field Service Building by the flagpole. Visitor parking is available across the street from the building.
- Make contact at the Dispatch window and let them know you are here to pick up a water meter from Meter Services.
- Provide receipt to Meter Services and fill out the Fire Hydrant Meter Contract. Contractor is solely responsible for all damages and parts as listed on the contract, including theft of the meter. The contractor is responsible for reporting an accurate monthly reading by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month or will be charged a minimum of 30,000 gallons.
