

**NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION**

TO THE RESIDENT QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT an election will be held within the City of Mesquite, Texas, on Tuesday, November 3, 2015, as provided in the resolution calling the election passed by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, a substantial copy of which resolution is printed below:

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CALLING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2015; PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT AND THE GIVING NOTICE OF THE ELECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND ENACTING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT**

WHEREAS, this City Council finds and determines that it is necessary and advisable to call and hold an election within said City on the proposition hereinafter set forth; Now, Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. Findings. The statements contained in the preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are adopted as findings of fact and as a part of the operative provisions hereof.

Section 2. Election Ordered; Propositions. An election shall be held in the City of Mesquite Texas (the "City"), on November 3, 2015, at which election the following proposition shall be submitted in accordance with law:

**PROPOSITION**

Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be authorized to issue and sell the bonds of said City in the aggregate principal amount of \$125,000,000, for the purpose of constructing, improving, extending, expanding, upgrading and developing two-lane residential streets, including, utility relocation, landscaping, sidewalks, traffic safety and operational improvements, drainage, the purchase of any necessary right-of-way, and other related costs; with said bonds to be issued in one or more series or issues, to mature serially or otherwise not to exceed 40 years from their date, and bear interest at such rate or rates, not to exceed the respective limits prescribed by law at the time of issuance, and to be sold at such price or prices, as the City Council in its discretion shall determine; and shall there be levied and pledged, assessed and collected annually ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said city in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity?

Section 3. Official Ballots. The official ballots for the election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" on the proposition with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such propositions to be expressed substantially as follows.

Section 4. Election Administration. Said election shall be administered by the Dallas County Elections Administrator and the Kaufman County Elections Administrator pursuant to the respective Joint Election Agreements. The Dallas County Elections Administrator shall administer the Election for the Dallas County portion of the City, and the Kaufman County Elections Administrator shall administer the Election for the Kaufman County portion of the City. City voters shall vote in the county in which they are registered.

Section 5. Precincts and Polling Places. The election precincts and the polling place for each such precinct on election day, are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, which is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof for all purposes. The City Secretary is authorized to modify Exhibit A to include additional or different election day polling places designated by the Elections Administrators and to conform to the Joint Election Services Agreements.

Section 6. Early Voting. (a) The Early Voting Polling Places for conducting early voting by personal appearance, and the addresses for early voting by mail, for said election only are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto. The City Secretary is authorized to modify Exhibit A to include additional or different early voting locations designated by the Elections Administrators and to conform to the Joint Election Agreements.

(b) The early voting ballots shall be canvassed by the Early Voting Ballot Boards, which shall be appointed and designated in accordance with the provisions of the Joint Election Agreements.

Section 7. Voting Hours; Period for Early Voting by Personal Appearance.

(a) On election day the polls shall be open from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

(b) The dates and hours for early voting by personal appearance at the Early Voting Polling Places shall be as described in Exhibit A hereto.

Section 8. Persons Qualified to Vote. All resident qualified electors of said City shall be permitted to vote in said election.

Section 9. Required Information. In accordance with the provisions of Section 3.009(b), Texas Election Code, it is hereby found and determined that:

(a) The proposition language that will appear on the ballot is set forth in Section 3 hereof.

(b) The purpose for which the bonds are to be authorized is set forth in Section 2 hereof.

(c) The principal amount of the bonds to be authorized is set forth in Sections 2 and 3 hereof.

(d) As set forth in Sections 2 and 3 hereof, if the bonds are approved by the voters, the City Council will be authorized to levy annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the City, within the limits prescribed by law, sufficient to pay the annual principal of and interest on the bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity.

(e) Based upon the bond market conditions at the date of adoption of this Resolution, the maximum interest rate for any series of the bonds is estimated to be 5.50% as calculated in accordance with applicable law. Such estimate takes into account a number of factors, including the issuance schedule, maturity schedule and the expected bond ratings of the proposed bonds. Such estimated maximum interest rate is provided as a matter of information, but is not a limitation on the interest rate at which the bonds, or any series thereof, may be sold.

(f) As set forth in Section 7 hereof, if the bonds are approved, they may be issued in one or more series over a period not to exceed 40 years.

(g) The aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the City's debt obligations which are secured by ad valorem taxes as of the beginning of the City's 2014-2015 fiscal year is \$121,960,000.

(h) The aggregate amount of the outstanding interest of the City's debt obligations which are secured by ad valorem taxes as of the beginning of the City's 2014-2015 fiscal year is \$39,741,456.

(i) The ad valorem debt service tax rate for the City for the 2014-2015 fiscal year is \$0.17780 per \$100 of taxable assessed valuation.

Section 10. Effective Date. In accordance with the provisions of V.T.C.A., Government Code, Section 1201.028, this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.
