



2016 Employee of the Year



Mesquite, TX – January 22, 2016 – Mark Hodges is the 2016 General Government Employee of the Year. Mark joined the City of Mesquite in 1989, and has consistently shown his dedication to the organization with his passion to serve the community.

Mark was recognized for leading the charge on the City's 50/50 Sidewalk Program to help homeowners replace sidewalks in disrepair. He was also an instrumental part of the team that developed the new Optimized Pavement Reconstruction Process which will be used in the residential street bond repair program.

This new reconstruction process will empower the City to complete street repairs in about half the time of traditional reconstruction. The process will also cost 40 percent less than street repairs in the past. These substantial savings in time and money will maximize the improvements made possible by the residential street bond program.

Mayor Stan Pickett presented Mark with the esteemed award on behalf of the City Council at the 2016 Mesquite Chamber of Commerce banquet.
