



2016 Certificate of Civic Achievement – Sergeant Tim Green

Mesquite, TX – April 18, 2016 – The Certificate of Civic Achievement is awarded to police employees who bring favorable recognition to the Department through their involvement in civic affairs while acting in the capacity of an employee and representative of the Mesquite Police Department.

In September 2014, Sergeant Tim Green was relaxing at home while looking at the online Texas Fishing Forum website. A fisherman had posted several photos demonstrating the abilities of his new fish finder. Sgt. Green noticed what appeared to be a car under water in one of the photos. Using the GPS coordinates Sergeant Green found that the location of the vehicle was in the south east corner of Lake O' the Pines. Sergeant Green called the local sheriff's department and advised them what he found.

A few days later he received a phone call from the area Game Warden. The Game Warden said that they had located the vehicle. When they recovered the car they found it belonged to a 50-year-old woman who was reported missing on March 16, 1987, and her remains were in the car. Thanks to Sergeant Green, local officials were able to solve a 27-year-old missing person case and give her family closure.
