The State Comptroller's Office reported a 2.5 percent increase in the City's sales tax collections for the month of September. September's report is based on sales reported by local businesses during the month of July. With the increase, collections are trending \$289,000 above budget; however, overall, sales tax collections are relatively flat with an increase of 1.0 percent for the fiscal year.
